

Recycling Uniform & Club Outfits

There is a collection box in the entrance hall of the school (by the office), for all uniform and club activity clothes - including Brownies, ballet, cricket cubs etc.

These items are sold in the week before and the week after school holidays. The sales are on the Mondays and Fridays, 9.15am and 3.10 - 3.30pm in the Key Stage 1 playground or the studio, weather dependent. School items are generally 50p - £1 and the club clothes are priced accordingly (e.g. recently sold a whole Brownie uniform for £10).

If you forget to bring your money on the day, don't worry as you can hand it into the office the next day - the main aim of these sales is to recycle the used clothes and the little money raised is a bonus - the club outfits raise a lot more money and are gratefully received!

In addition to selling the decent school uniform, marked school jumpers and summer dresses are used to make craft items to be sold at fairs etc, so please still donate these (only At Andrew's jumpers and summer dresses, if marked).

Obviously all of this depends on your donations and your custom, so please think of us when cleaning out or needing to shop in advance and those who might have forgotten the odd item.
